- List each sound, its corresponding emotion, and describe why you think the sound conveys that emotion
- Utilize the three sounds you selected to compose a four measure composition using <a href="https://onlinesequencer.net/">https://onlinesequencer.net/</a>. Use elements such as tempo, rhythm, and melodic and harmonic structure to convey an emotion using music.
